

## **Election Inspector**

The Charter Township of Harrison accepts applications for election inspectors year round. Election inspectors are asked to be at their assigned precincts by 6:00 a.m. on Election Day. Voting precincts open at 7:00 a.m. and remain open until all voters in line at 8:00 p.m. have voted. The chairperson and inspectors then close the polls and prepare the precinct report totals to be taken to the Clerk's office. All inspectors are asked to remain with their precinct until all closing procedures have been completed and the chairperson and an assistant leave to report to the Clerk's office.

All chairpersons and inspectors are required to attend a training session prior to elections. Forms are sent out requesting your availability for the election. Once the form is returned to the Clerk's office or we are notified via phone at (586) 466-1404 or fax at (586) 466-1424 of your availability, a letter will be sent with the time and date of the training session. The training sessions are usually held in the Beaufait Addition/Rosso Hall from 6:30 or 7:00 until 8:00 or 8:30 p.m. a week or two prior to the election. Serving as an election inspector is a wonderful way to give back to your community.
